- Was Egyptian (Gen 16)
- Identified with Mt. Sinai and slavery (Gal 4)

- Father of Rachel and Leah
- Brother of Rebekah
- Deceived Jacob into marrying Leah (Gen 29)

- Firstborn of Jacob and Leah (Gen 29)
- Forfeit his birthright (Gen 35)
- Saved Joseph from being killed (Gen 37)

- Joseph's firstborn
- His name was given to remember Joseph's forgotten trouble (Gen 41:51)
- Became a tribe of Israel

- Son of Jacob and Leah
- Head of the priestly tribe
- Ancestor to Moses and Aaron (Ex 2:1)

- The King of Salem
- Blessed Abram (Gen 14)
- Jesus belongs to his priestly order (Ps 110; Heb 5-6)

- Was initially barren (Gen 30)
- Mom of Joseph and Benjamin
- Typologically wept over Herod's massacre of Jewish children (Mt 2:18)

- Daughter to Jacob and Leah
- Defiled by Shechem, son of Hamor (Gen 34)
- Full sister of Simeon and Levi

- Joseph's second son
- His name was given to commemorate Joseph's fruitfulness (Gen 41:52)
- Became a tribe of Israel

- Jacob's second with Leah (Gen 29)
- Detained by Joseph in Egypt
- Tribe surrounded by Judah

- Son of Jacob and Leah
- Name means honor
- Tribe dwelt near the coast (Gen 49:13)

- Son of Jacob and Leah
- Ancestor of David and Jesus
- The scepter shall not depart from Judah (Gen 49:10)

- Son of Jacob and Bilhah
- Name sounds like the Hebrew for “judged”
- Ancestor of Samson (Judg 13:2)

- Son of Jacob and Leah
- Name sounds like the Hebrew “wages” or “hire”
- His tribe joined Deborah and Barak in battle (Judg 5:15)

- Son of Jacob and Billhah
- Name sounds like the Hebrew for “wrestling”
- Tribe was place of Christ’s ministry (Isa 9:1-2; Mt 4:13-16)

- Son of Jacob and Zilpah
- Name sounds like the Hebrew for “happy”
- Jacob prophesied his land would be rich (Gen 49:20)

- A priest of Midian
- Father of Moses’ wife Zipporah
- Advised Moses to appoint judges (Ex 18)

- Jacob’s youngest (with Rachel)
- Not guilty of selling Joseph into slavery
- Favored by Joseph (Gen 43:34)

- Son of Jacob and Zilpah
- Name sounds like the Hebrew for “raid”
- Prophecy related to name (Gen 49:19)

- Pagan god of the Ammonites
- Worship involved child sacrifice (Eze 20; Jer 32:35)
- Solomon and his wives worshipped (1 Ki 11)

- Fish-man god of the Philistines
- Head and hands cut off before the ark of Yahweh (1 Sam 5)
- Philistines credited for the capture of Samson (Judg 16)

- A Levite
- Rose up against Moses
- Swallowed up by the earth (Num 16)

- Amorite king
- Took land from Moabite king
- Israel defeated with edge of the sword for refusing passage (Num 21)

- Grandson of Aaron (Ex 6:25)
- Slew Israelite man and Midianite woman for committing adultery
- Sounded trumpets in battle with Midian (Num 31)

- Caleb's nephew
- The first of the judges
- The king of Mesopotamia given into his hand (Judg 3)

- The sons of Aaron
- On Sinai with Moses, Aaron, and 70 elders (Ex 24:1)
- Executed for offering strange fire (Lev 10)

- Brought a good report from Canaan (Num 13)
- One of two not to die in the wilderness (Num 14:24)
- Leader after Joshua died (Judg 1)

- King of Bashan
- Came against Israel at Edrei
- Israel defeated and possessed his land (Num 21)

- King of Moab
- Bribed Balaam to curse Israel (Num 22-24)
- Moab was cursed instead of Israel (Num 24:17)

- Helped the spies in Jericho
- An ancestor of Christ (Mt 1:5)
- Had the faith of Abraham (Josh 2)

- Tola– 23 yrs (Judg 10)
- Jair– 22 yrs (Judg 10)

Judges 12:8-15

- Ibzar– in Bethlehem for 7 yrs
- Elon– 10 yrs
- Abdon–8 yrs

- The kinsman redeemer of Ruth
- Ancestor of David and Christ
- Belonged to clan of Elimelech– Ruth's widower's family
(See the book of Ruth)

- Given to David for slaying Philistines (1 Sam 18)
- Rescued David from Saul (1 Sam 19)
- Married to another man (1 Sam 25; 2 Sam 3)

- A judge of Israel
- A prophetess (Judg 4)
- Judged in the hill country of Ephraim

- Judge of Israel
- Delivered Israel from Moab (with the Ammonites and Amalekites) (Judg 3)
- Killed Eglon, king of Moab

- Delivered from Ammon
- Rash vow bound daughter to offering (Judg 11)
- Conflict with Ephraim (Judg 12)

- Stole silver from his mother
- House idols paid for by his mother, and hired a Levite as a priest.
- A picture of idolatrous life in the land (Judg 17-18)

- A Philistine warrior
- Six cubits tall
- Defeated by David in the Valley of Elah (1 Sam 17)

- Commander of Israel's army
- Killed by Joab (2 Sam 3)
- Former wife of Nabal
- David married for her discernment (1 Sam 25)
- Rescued by David from Captivity (1 Sam 30)
- Asked permission to "pin Saul to the earth" (1 Sam 26)
- Killed Abner with Joab
- Defeated Edomites and Ammonites
- Jonathan's son, crippled from childhood injury (2 Sam 4:4)
- Favored by David (2 Sam 9)
- Property given to Ziba (2 Sam 16)
- Son of Saul assumed command of Israel (2 Sam 2)
- Reigned for two years
- Offended Abner who joined David (2 Sam 3)
- Delivered Davidic covenant (2 Sam 7)
- Delivered David's chastisement for sin (2 Sam 12)
- Helped secure Solomon's throne (1 Ki 1)
- Wife of Uriah the Hittite
- Committed adultery with David (2 Sam 11)
- Mother of Solomon
- Idol of Philistines, Sidonians, and Phoenicians
- Repeatedly served by Israel
- High places defiled by Josiah (2 Kings 23)
- Violated his sister Tamar (not from Genesis)
- Killed by Absalom (2 Sam 13)
- Firstborn of David with Ahinoam

- Attempted to usurp kingdom (1 Ki 1)
- Executed by Solomon

- King of Israel
- Intense advocate of idolatry
- Confronted by Elijah (1 Ki 18)

- Daughter of Sidonian king, wife of Ahab
- Cut off the prophets threatened Elijah (1 Ki 18)
- Executed by Jehu (2 Ki 9)

- King of Judah, son of Asa
- Fortified Judah against Israel (2 Ch 17:2)
- Promoted scriptural instruction and removed idolatry

- Captain of Israel's army
- King of Israel
- Killed by Hoshea (2 Ki 15)

- Worthless man of Benjamin
- Led a rebellion against David (2 Sam 20)
- A greater threat than Absalom (2 Sam 20:6)

- King of Judah for 41 yrs
- Ancestor of Christ (aka Asaph) (Mt 1:7)
- Pleased God by removing idols from Judah

- Had oversight of Ahab's house
- Hid 100 prophets from Jezebel
- Told Ahab where Elijah was (1 Ki 18)

- Prophesied judgment on Ahab (1 Ki 22)
- Struck on the cheek by Chenaanah
- Seized and imprisoned by Ahab

- King of Israel
- Captured by Shalmaneser of Assyria (2 Ki 17)
- Last king of Israel (Hos 10:7)

- King of Judah
- Killed his brothers to strengthen his throne
- Elijah prophesied judgment on (2 Ch 21)

- King of Israel appointed by Elisha (2 Ki 9)
- Cut off the house of Ahab (2 Ch 22)
- Did not walk in the law of the Yahweh (2 Ki 10:31)

- From so. Arabian peninsula
- Questioned Solomon (1 Ki 10)
- Testifies against unbelief (Mt 12:38-42)

- King of Israel, son of Jehu
- Sought the Lord at the oppression of Hazael of Aram (2 Ki 13)
- Did not turn from his sin

- King of Judah, son of Azariah
- Right in God's eyes (2 Ch 27)
- Prevailed over the Ammonites

- Wicked wife of Jehoram
- Grand-daughter of Omri, king of Israel
- "Treason! Treason!" (2 Ki 11)

- King of Judah
- Son of Jehoram and Athaliah
- Walked wickedly; reigned one year (2 Ki 8)

- Commander of the Aramean Army (2 Ki 5)
- Healed through washing in the Jordan seven times
- Others in the land not healed (Lk: 4:27)

- King of Judah, son of Ahaziah
- Saved from Athaliah for six years (2 Ki 11)
- Not to be confused with Joash/Jehoash of Israel

- King of Israel, son of Joash
- Prosperity during reign (2 Ki 14)
- Preached to by Amos

- King of Israel
- Fought with Asa of Judah (1 Ki 15)
- Built Ramah in attempt to blockade Asa

- King of Assyria
- Overthrew Israel and brought it into exile (2 Ki 17)
- Hoshea paid tribute to him

- King of Judah, son of Jehoiakim
- A wicked 3 month reign
- Also called Jeconiah (1 Ch 3:16) and Coniah (Jer 22:24)

- Pagan god of Moab, Ammon, and Amorites
- Worshipped by Israel
- High places built by Solomon (1 Ki 11)

- King of Judah, son of Hezekiah
- Did more evil than the Amorites (2 Ki 21)
- Turned to God when brought to Babylon with hooks (2 Ch 33)

- King of Judah, son of Amaziah
- Also called Azariah
- Reigned righteously. Defeated Philistines (2 Ch 26)

- King of Judah, son of Manasseh (2 Ch 33:21-25)
- Followed his father in wickedness, but not humility
- Killed by his servants

- King of Assyria
- Attempted to overthrow Jerusalem in Hezekiah's reign
- Angel of Yahweh struck down 185,000 of his men (2 Ki 19)

- King of Judah, son of Josiah
- Named changed from Eliakim by Pharaoh Neco (2 Ki 23)
- Wicked reign. Paid tribute to Pharaoh

- King of Judah, son of Jehoash
- Did right, but not as David (2 Ki 14)
- Struck down 10,000 Edomites

- Did evil in God's sight (2 Ki 15)
- Last of Jehu's dynasty (2 Ki 15:12)

- King of Persia
- Ezra and Nehemiah returned under reign (Ezr 7, Neh 5:14)
- Son of Xerxes

- A Horonite
- Opposed the Jews during the rebuilding of the wall (Neh 2)
- Family intermarried with royalty (Neh 13)

- Wife of Xerxes (Est 1)
- Refused the king's request
- Her crown given to Esther (Est 2)

- Cousin to Esther
- Brought in captivity from Jerusalem (Est 2)
- Honored by the Persian king (Est 6)

- High priest under Josiah
- Found the book of the law in the temple (2 Ki 22)
- Father of Jeremiah (Jer 1:1)

- King of Persia
- Decreed the return of Israel (2 Ch 36) Prophesied (Is 44)
- Zerubbabel returned under (Ezr 2)

- Persian king
- Temple rebuilt under reign (Ez 5-6, Hag 1:iff)
- Zechariah preached during his reign (Zech 1)

- An Ammonite
- Opposed the Jews during the rebuilding of the wall (Neh 2)
- Worked with Eliashib the priest (Neh 13)

- Persian king in Esther
- AKA Ahasuerus
- Almost annihilated the Jews (Est 5-7)

- Regent of last Babylonian king
- Saw the handwriting on the wall (Dan 5)
- Kingdom taken by Darius the Mede

- Calls those who lack sense (Prov 9:iff)
- Fears God (Prov 9:10)
- Brings blessing (Prov 8)

- Made king of Judah by Nebuchadnezzar (2 Ki 24)
- Alliance with Egypt (Eze 17)
- Imprisoned Jeremiah (Jer 32)

- General of Cyrus the Persian
- Took the kingdom from Belshazzar (Dan 5:30)
- Not to be confused with Darius I

- Head of Xerxes' officials
- Provoked Xerxes to annihilate the Jews
- Hanged on the gallows he built (Est 7)
