**Purpose:** For the sinner to gain favor with God

**Object:** A male animal without blemish

**Scripture:** Leviticus 1:1-17

**Purpose:** Made out of gratitude to God, for fellowship with him, and for public rejoicing

**Object:** Unblemished male (king), animal according to what was affordable— always unblemished

**Scripture:** Leviticus 3:1-17

**Purpose:** Made for an unintentional sin in the holy things of God

**Object:** Unblemished ram

**Scripture:** Leviticus 5:14-19

**Object:** Bull (priest or congregation), male goat (ruler), female goat, lamb, pair of doves, pigeons, meal (individual according to what was affordable)

**Scripture:** Leviticus 4:1-5:13

**Practiced in:** Abib (March/April)

**Scripture:** Leviticus 23:9-14;  
Numbers 28:2

**Purpose:** For Israel to remember their deliverance from Egypt

**Practiced in:** Abib (March/April)

**Scripture:** Exodus 12:1-20; 13:3-10;  
Leviticus 23:5-8; Numbers 9:1-14;  
28:17-26; Deuteronomy 16:1-8

**Purpose:** A solemn day of rest, proclaimed with trumpets

**Practiced in:** Tishri (Sept/Oct)

**Scripture:** Leviticus 23:23-25;  
Numbers 29:1-6

**Purpose:** For Israel to offer their first fruits of harvest offered to God seven weeks after Firstfruits

**Practiced in:** Sivan (May/June)

**Scripture:** Exodus 23:16; 34:22;  
Leviticus 23:15-21; Numbers 28:26-31;  
Deuteronomy 16:9-12

**Purpose:** For Israel to remember their wilderness wanderings

**Practiced in:** Tishri (Sept/Oct)

**Scripture:** Exodus 23:16; 34:22  
Leviticus 23:33-36. 39-43;  
Numbers 29:12-38;  
Deuteronomy 16:13-15

**Purpose:** Atonement made for Israel (including the priesthood) and the tabernacle

**Practiced in:** Tishri (Sept/Oct)

**Scripture:** Leviticus 16; 23:26-32  
Numbers 29:7-11
